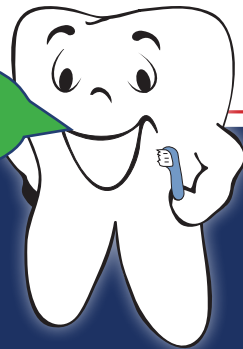

A patient's visit to our office begins in our reception area and continues in a Hygiene Area Room. Oral x-rays, routine cleanings, oral health exams and preventive services, such as sealants are completed in a comfortable and relaxing atmosphere.

Dental caries (cavities) often develop in the pits and fissures of the teeth of children and teenagers. Dental decay and fractured teeth can cause pain, infection, loss of self esteem and diminished school performance. Fillings and/or crowns can restore the natural shape and appearance of teeth.

If dental decay has progressed into the pulp (nerve) of a tooth, endodontic therapy (a root canal) can be performed by our skilled doctors, eliminating any infection and pain. Treatment is then completed with a crown to preserve the tooth.

If dental treatment beyond regular preventive services is necessary, Vital Smiles provides comprehensive dental services in kid friendly treatment rooms.

Dental visits should begin around the time of the patients' first birthday.
